**BoG 07.04 Appointment of Deputy Director and amendment in first Statutes of NIT's**  
**Agenda:** The first Statutes 18 (2) to (5) has a provision of appointment of Deputy Director in the NIT's. However the Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development vide letter F.No.33/6/2013 dated 27/10/2014 stipulate that appointment of Deputy Director in NITs is to be made by the Board as per Section 17(5) and 24(a) of the NITTSE Act, 2007 until further amendments are taken up in NITTSE Act. It is, therefore, necessary to make amendment in Statutes 18(1) in conjunction with amendment in Section 17(5) and Section 24 of the NITTSE Act, 2007 as under:  
"The appointment of the Deputy Director shall be made by the Board on the recommendations of the Selection Committee constituted in terms of provision under Statutes 23(5) (b) of the First Statutes of NITs.  
The Board is requested to approve the amendment in First Statutes as stated above. The decision of the Board will be communicated to MHRD for onward transmission for approval of the Hon'ble Visitor.

**Resolution:** Approved.

**BoG 07.05: Information regarding staff recruited in Academic Year 2014.**

The term of all the above members will be of two years. The Director of the Institute shall take appropriate action on recommendations of the Grievance Cell. Board is requested to approve the constitution of Grievance Cell.

**BoG 07.08: Approval regarding constitution of Women Cell**

**Agenda:** In order to address the issue of the women employees, it is proposed to constitute a Women Cell as under:

The term of all the above members will be of two years. The Cell shall submit its report to the Director for further appropriate action. Board is requested to approve the constitution of Women Cell.

**Resolution:** Constitution of the Cell is approved. Nomenclature may be changed as per Vishakha Guidelines, keeping in view the Gender sensitization related issues.

**BoG 07.09: Approval regarding appointment of teachers on contract on the basis of student faculty ratio.**

**Agenda:** The Institute has received sanction of 50 teaching posts till the academic year 2013-14. The intake of the students is ever increasing and during the year 2015,

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230 additional students are likely to be enrolled. The student's strength of the Institute is at present 676. On the basis of approved norms of student's-faculty ratio of 12:1 the total required strength of the faculty in Academic Year 2015-16 shall be 75. The Institute therefore, requires additional posts of faculty for effective functioning.

Board is requested to approve as a policy to appoint of teachers on adhoc basis (against actual student faculty ratio) till the regular sanction is received from MHRD and posts are filled up.

**Resolution:** Approved. It is desirable to appoint Senior Faculty to strengthen Academic Activities in the Institute and Board wishes that efforts shall be made to appoint Senior Faculty.

**BoG 07.10:** Approval regarding regularization of services of Assistant Professor on Contract on completion of PhD.

**Agenda:** Institute has appointed M.Tech. qualified teachers as Assistant Professor (on Contract) after due selection procedure. These teachers are appointed in Three -Tier Structure and Four Tier Flexible Structure. There is no issue regarding teachers appointed in Four-Tier flexible structure. However, as Three-Tier structure does not exist now, directives of the Board are sought, whether Assistant Professor (on Contract) in Three-Tier shall be considered for regularization as per process for Three-Tier Structure or for Four-Tier Structure.

The proposed regularization procedures are detailed in **Annexure BoG 07.05** alongwith relevant RR. It is further added that the Recruitment Rules stipulate that any change in Pay or Grade Pay shall be on the recommendation of duly constituted Selection Committee and hence the concerned faculty member is required to appear before duly constituted Selection Committee.

The Board is requested to consider the regularization procedures for approval and give directions for the procedure to be adopted for Three-Tier faculty members. Applications for regularization of Dr. A K Yadav and Dr. A Mondal shall be processed accordingly.

**Resolution:** The Board approved the proposal with following replacement of items 1, 2 & 3 for Assistant Professor (on Contract) in three tier structures.

1. On completion of Ph.D., Selection Committee (as per NIT Act) in personal interview shall consider the application of Assistant Professor (on Contract) for Grade Pay of ₹7,000/-.
2. It found suitable for continuation , on approval of BoG, the applicant faculty shall be placed in AGP of ₹7,000/- from the date of acquiring Ph.D. as Assistant Professor (on Contract) till the applicant faculty is selected as Assistant Professor in Grade Pay of ₹8,000/-. In other case, the applicant faculty will be relieved from services of National Institute of Technology, Uttarakhand.
3. The applicant faculty shall be regularized in four tier flexible structure on completion of one year probation after being placed in Grade Pay of ₹8,000/-.

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**BoG 07.11: To consider resignation of Dr. Deepak Kumar Bahera and policy for granting lien.**

**Agenda:** Dr. Deepak Kumar Bahera had joined NIT Uttarakhand services as Assistant Professor in the Department of Science and Humanities in August 2013. He applied for the post of Assistant Professor in NIT Patna through proper channel, got selected and joined NIT Patna in December 2014 after tendering technical resignation at NIT Uttarakhand and also applied for lien. Due to paucity of time he was relieved from the services of NIT Uttarakhand in anticipation of the approval of the Board. Relevant documents are enclosed as **Annexure BoG 07.06**

It is submitted that the lien period is generally of two years. This being very upcoming Institute, starves for adequate strength of faculty to run the courses. It is therefore, proposed to retain the faculty at least for a period of 3 years, to be eligible for applying for lien. The application of Dr. D.K. Behara shall therefore be considered on same line. And his technical resignation be accepted. Board is request to approve the above proposal.

**Resolution:** The Board did not approve the Lien in respect of Dr D K Behara. The Board further suggested to frame the policy as per mobility order and place before the Board.

**BoG 07.12: Regularization of claims for travel charges..**

**Agenda:** Dr. Anirban Mukherjee, Assistant Professor Department of Science and Humanities and Mr. Vineet P.Chandran, Assistant Professor Department of Electrical Engineering have availed the LTC but booked their tickets through 'Make My Trip'.

Dr. A.K. Chaubey, Assistant Professor, Department of Science and Humanities has submitted a ticket which is for Air India but through 'Make My Trip' for attending International conference.

Though the claims are not as per the existing rules, which envisage that air tickets shall be purchased directly from Air India booking counters or authorised agents, the claimants may be permitted the reimbursement without facilitation charges to the private agency.

Since these financial implications are out of the powers of the Director, the Board is requested to approve the above proposal as a special case.

**Resolution:** Withdrawn in view of GOI Orders.



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**BoG 07.13: Regarding vacation leave of the faculties.**

**Agenda:** As per CCS leave rules Vacation Leave is not admissible during first year of service and Vacation Leave is calculated on the basis of Academic Year.

However there are no clear instructions regarding Earned Leave or the Vacation Leave during the period between the end of the first year of service and beginning of immediate next Academic Year.

Following method of calculations based on the CCS rules is proposed:

1. During first Year of Service 30 Days of Earned Leave in lieu of 60 days of Vacation shall be admissible on pro rata basis (2.5 days accumulated at the end of every month) for convenience of teaching staff.
2. Academic Year starting after completion of one Year of service shall be admissible for availing 60 days of Vacation. Academic Year starts on the day of Enrolment of Autumn Semester.
3. During the period between completion of one year of service and beginning of new Academic Year, teaching staff shall be entitled to Vacation Leave in proportion of 5 days per calendar month and 1 day for every 6 days of balance days. Fractional leave of 0.5 days and above shall be rounded off to 1.0 and fractional leave below 0.5 shall be rounded off to zero.

The Board is requested to approve the above proposed basis of calculation of leave and permit to re-calculate leave as per above method. Leave granted in excess, if any, will be adjusted from the leave to be earned in future.

**Resolution:** As Director is empowered to interpret rules and prepare guidelines, hence item is withdrawn.

**BoG 07.14: To approve the Special Casual Leave for Ph.D. work.**

**Agenda:** Majority of Assistant Professors (on Contract) in Engineering Departments and all Trainee Teachers are perusing PhD in Part-Time mode. They can visit the Institutes of their study during the vacation. Quality and pace of their PhD work suffers due to such visits after long gaps. To overcome this serious issue, it is proposed that Special Casual Leave of 5 days per month during non-vacation period be admissible to such members of faculty for the purpose of their PhD work subject to the condition that they spend at least 45 days of vacation at the Institute of study. If such permission is granted, the Department shall share the teaching and other assignments and expenses for such visits shall be permissible through CPDA of concerned faculty member.

The Board is requested to approve the proposal.

**Resolution:** Approved in view of facilitating the faculty carry out quality PhD work.



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**BoG 07.15** To approve the policy for recovery of amount in case of unsatisfactory performance of members of faculty deputed to pursue Ph.D.

**Agenda:** Institute deposes members of faculty for course work to pursue PhD. Such deputed teachers furnish a bond of Rs. 4.00 lakh amounting to approximately 6 months's salary. However many teachers are spending much lesser time during deputation and actual expenses made are less than Rs. 4.00 Lakh. Under the circumstances it is proposed that only actual amount spent by the Institute shall be recovered from such a member of faculty if need of recovery arises.  
The Board is requested to approve the proposal.

**Resolution:** The Board approved the proposal for recovery of ₹ four lakh or actual amount spent on deputation, whichever is less.

**BoG 07.16** Academic reviews as recommended by NIT Review Committee

**Agenda:** The NIT Council has accepted the report of NIT Review Committee under the Chairmanship of Dr. Anil Kakodkar. The report expects an extensive academic review from external agency conducted periodically. Members of faculty of NITUK being at very initial stage, need extensive mentoring and monitoring. It is proposed to have two independent mechanisms for monitoring and mentoring as detailed below.

**Academic Audit Committee (AAC) (One for each Department)**

This committee shall consist of three to five Professors / Associate Professors from IIT Roorkee and IIT Delhi nominated by the Director NITUK. This committee shall review every semester all the academic activities i.e. teaching, evaluation, research etc. department wise and give assessment of individual teacher and the department. This committee shall also suggest the improvement areas. These reports shall be addressed to the Director and report on individual shall be a confidential.

**Academic Mentor Committee (AMC) (One for each Department)**

This committee shall be of 3-7 Professors / Associate Professors from any IIT (but not from AAC) as recommended by HoD of concerned Department. Members of these committees shall visit Institute together or individually. They shall closely interact with the faculty and Department to guide teachers in all academic activities. They can give suggestions for growth of the Department to the respective HoD. This committee not being in the evaluation mode, faculty shall be free to interact with them and share their shortcomings.

Visiting members of the committees shall be provided with TA/DA and local hospitality in addition to honorarium as per Institute norms.

The board is requested to approve the proposal.

**Resolution:** Approved with following directives:

1. Academic Audit Committee should be replaced by Academic Assessment Committee.
2. Suggestion for names shall be invited from the Department for nomination on Academic Assessment Committee.

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3. Details of the proposed process of academic assessment should be prepared and placed before Board for consideration.

**BoG 07.17: Approval for Sponsoring Best Innovation Awards.**

**Agenda:**

In support to Govt. of India's policy to encourage the students to do the innovative work, it is proposed that the NIT, Uttarakhand shall sponsor All India Innovation Awards from amongst innovations submitted by students from NITs as under.

First Award - Rs. 100,000/- and Certificate

Second Award - Rs. 50,000/- and Certificate

Third Award - Rs.25,000/-

To motivate NITUK students exclusive awards for innovations for NITUK students shall be as under

Best NITUK Innovation - Rs.50,000/- and Certificate

Consolation Prizes for NITUK students (5 Nos.) - Rs. 10,000/- each and a Certificate

For this purpose, NIT Uttarakhand will invite innovation reports from all NIT students and choose best 10 out of them for demonstration and presentation at NIT Uttarakhand. A committee of three senior professors from respective field (from outside NIT Uttarakhand) will be constituted for the purpose. A certificate from the respective NIT Director will be requested indicating that the particular work is the original one and done by the concerned student. If approved, provision will be made in Institute Budget.

The Board is requested to approve the above proposal.

**Resolution:** Approved.

**BoG 07.18: Permission for ceiling on cash award instituted by the Council of Students Activities (CSA).**

**Agenda:**

The CSA is organizing various competitions for students of NIT, Uttarakhand in the field of cultural, sports and technology. To boost the participation, CSA desires to give cash awards to the winners. It is proposed to permit CSA to give away the cash awards not exceeding Rs.10000/- in any single event and not more than 10% of the total CSA budget for all events taken together.

The Board is requested to approve the above proposal.

**Resolution:** Since the matter is within the powers of the Director, item is withdrawn.

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

**BoG 08.03 Nominations on Board of Governors**

As per the NIT Act, the Board of Governors consists eleven members including Chairperson. Dr. A.S. Dhundi who was representing teachers as a member has resigned and relived from this Institute service. Dr. Pawan Kumar Rakesh, Assistant Professor in Mechanical Engineering is completing his term on 17/07/2015.

Nomination on the Board of Governors as a teacher representative is necessary to be made. It is proposed that Dr. M.S. Khatri, Assistant Professor, Physics shall be appointed as a member w.e.f. 18.07.2015 (vice Dr. A.S. Dhundi resigned) and Dr. I. M. Nagpure, Assistant Professor, Physics may be nominated w.e.f. 18.07.2015 (vice Dr. Pawan Kr. Rakesh). The term of appointment for both the above member shall be one year from the date of their nomination.

Board is requested to approve above proposal.

**BoG 08.04 Regarding deputation of senior faculty from IIT/NITS.**

As per BOG resolution vide item no 07.09 It is necessary to appoint Senior Faculty to strengthen Academic Activities of the Institute. The efforts are being made to appoint senior faculty but the Institute is unable to attract senior faculty perhaps may be because of hilly terrain and tough geographical conditions.

To attract senior faculty it is proposed that some high-performing senior IIT/NIT faculty member shall be invited to spend a semester at NIT Uttarakhand. A special pay of Rs 2 lakhs / semester shall be provided to such senior faculty as recommended by Kakodkar committee report and approved by council of NITs. In continuation of this it is proposed to implement this scheme with following features:

1. Salary paid shall be as per the substantive salary in the parent institute.
2. NIT Uttarakhand shall pay leave salary, pension contribution to the parent Institute as per central Government rules.
3. NIT Uttarakhand shall provide accommodation facility in hired guest house.

BOG is requested to approve above proposal.



**BoG 08.05 - Regarding construction of permanent campus at Sumari.**

Administrative approval for the expenditure for construction has been sought from BoG in its 5<sup>th</sup> Meeting dated 05/02/2014 vide agenda item no. **BoG 05.07**. The NBCC has submitted the revised estimate the copy of which is placed at **Annexure BOG 08.02**.

With reference to the above it is to mention that initially during 2013 a preliminary cost estimate amounting to Rs.188 crs (including contingencies @ 3% & NBCC implementation charges @10 %) was prepared for the works related to the site development only on the basis of CPWD plinth area rate for the NIT Uttrakhand. Cost related to works for creating terraces was not taken into the account due to non finalization of Master plan & building blocks as the requirement of buildings & sizes thereof were yet to be frozen.

Subsequently after finalization of Master plan & building blocks, preliminary cost estimate for site development along with the terracing & RCC retaining wall 12 m to 18 m high was worked out to Rs. 1200 cr approximately. In this regard a meeting was held in NBCC office on dated 17.04.2015 where your good self & our associate consultants were also present. During meeting it was decided to consult IIT Roorkee for their advice. Accordingly meeting was held on 24.04.2015 at IIT Roorkee to discuss various aspects for creating Terraces.

After lot of discussions our associate consultant (DDF consultant) has made two options for the terracing of the site with soil stabilization using shotcrete method to create the terraces for placing the building blocks, in order to economize the total cost for Terracing & site development.

#### Option - I

Creating terraces with 12m to 18 m high retaining wall in steps using shotcrete for soil stabilization. The preliminary estimated cost works out to Rs. 1116.87 cr (Rs.180.87 cr for site development works & Rs. 936.00 for cutting filling & 12 m to 18 m high soil stabilization in steps for creating terraces)


#### Option - II

Creating terraces with 4 m high retaining wall single height using soil nailing with shotcrete for soil stabilization. The preliminary estimated cost works out to Rs.640.87 cr (Rs.180.87 cr. for site development works & Rs. 460.00 cr. for cutting filling & 4 m high soil stabilization in steps for creating terraces)

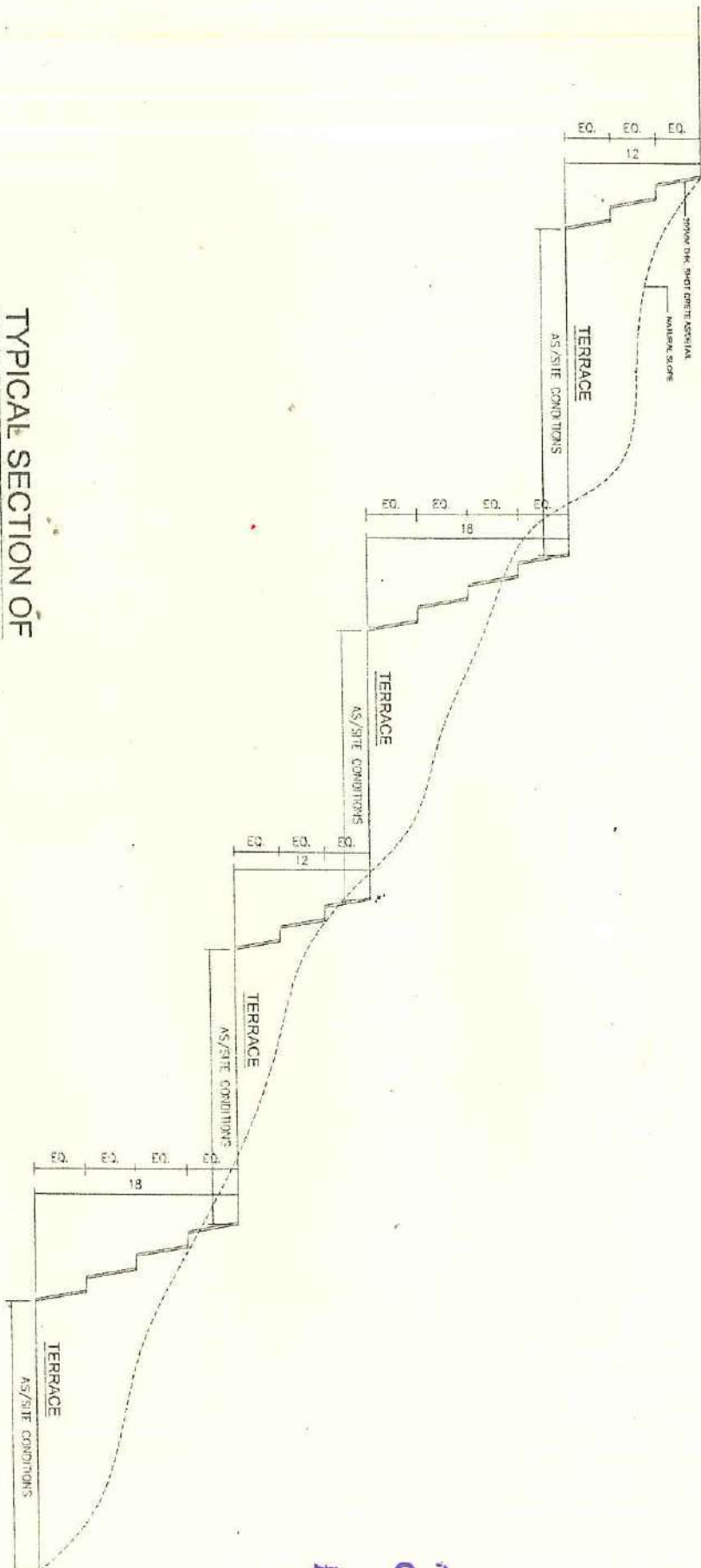

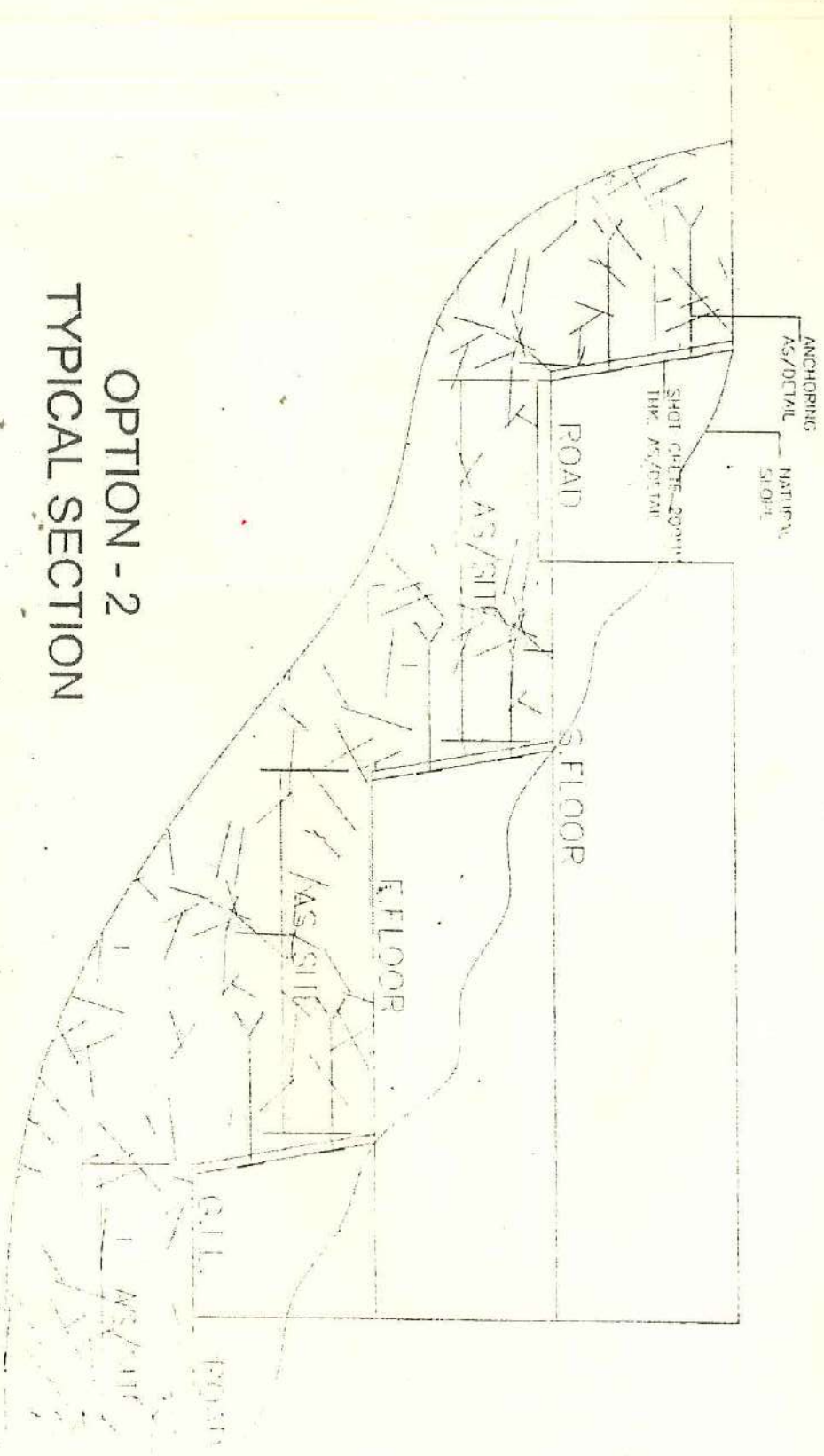

The Boundary Wall work of Permanent Campus has started finally on 15.06.2014 due to delay in land clearance and further it was held up due to disturbance of local people for a month and now it is in progress and nearing completion in stretch 'A' & B. For stretch 'C' as discussed we have made the sample of the RCC boundary wall. We have already expressed during the meeting held with you on dated 14.10.2015, that it is difficult to go for RCC fencing work in 'C' stretch as it is inaccessible due to thick forest, steep terrane and for want of approach road. Finally NBCC suggested in Stretch 'C' for similar channel link fencing, as we are adopting in stretch A & B. 

In compliance of order dated 17/04/15 by Hon'ble High Court, Nainital, in writ petition (SB) No. 120 of 2015, I am hereby sincerely requesting to the Board for considering my case for regularization for the post of Assistant Professor w.e.f award of Ph.D degree.

The brief facts of the case are that I had passed my Bachelor of Engineering Degree in Mechanical Engineering in the year 2006 from the University of Rajasthan and the M.Tech. Degree in the year 2008 from I.I.T. Delhi. I was enrolled for the full time MHRD sponsored Ph.D. programme on 31-12-2009 at I.I.T.Roorkee, under the guidance of Prof. Ravi Kumar (MIED, IIT R) and Prof. Akhilesh Gupta (MIED, IIT R). I had submitted my thesis on topic "Asymmetric Ballooning of Pressure Tube under LOCA in Indian PHWR" on 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2013 at I.I.T. Roorkee and subsequently my viva-voce examination for Ph.D degree was held on 20-8-2014. The Provisional degree on successful completion of requirements for Ph.D was received to me of 29-08-14. The true copy of the testimonials are attached herewith and marked as Annexure no. 1.

In the month of March, 2013, NIT Uttarakhand has issued an advertisement no. 1 of 2013 for different teaching post including that of Assistant Prof. Mechanical Engineering in pay band-III, Rs. 15600-39100 with AGP-6000 and the last date of the submission of application was 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2013. True copy of the advertisement no. 1 of 2013 is attached herewith and marked as Annexure no. 2.

The eligibility qualification for appointment as Assistant Professor in Mechanical Engineering department in pay band-III, Rs. 15600-39100 with AGP-6000, in the clause-2 of the advertisement provides that for the said post, the qualification required was M.Tech and the Ph.D. work from a reputed institute must be in an

advance stage. The age limit prescribed for the aforesaid post was for 30 years and, hence, I was eligible in all the counts, had submitted the application form and my application form was duly considered and thereafter, facing a written examination followed by an interview, I was selected on the aforesaid post. The appointment letter was issued to me on 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 for the post of Assistant Professor on contract in the department of Mechanical Engineering. True copy of the appointment letter dated 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2013 is attached herewith and marked as Annexure no. 3.

The appointment letter contained the terms and condition of the appointment of Assistant Professor on contract and apart from other condition, condition no. 3 has been provided, which is as follows:

*3- Contract period- The appointment shall be on contract basis for a maximum period of five years. Initially, the appointment will be issued for three years. The contract will be renewable every year on the conditions of good performance in teaching, good conduct and satisfactory progress in Ph.D. work. The contract position will be regularized with effect from the date of acquiring Ph.D. degree at appropriate AGP and increment as admissible. This contractual service will be counted for administrative and other service benefits. During their service, they will also be eligible to draw an annual increment.*

I had reported for joining the institute in the forenoon of 25<sup>th</sup> July, 2013 and after joining the institute, a contract was entered for service for the post of Assistant Professor between me and the institute. True copy of the joining letter and the contract of service to the post of Assistant Professor, is attached herewith and marked as Annexure no. 4.

The contract of service was executed on 27<sup>th</sup> July, 2013 specifically contained the Clause-2 and the same is quoted as herein under:

*2- The part no. 1 shall be on service under the agreement for a maximum period of five years. The contract shall be renewed every year on satisfactory progress in Ph.D. work, good performance in teaching and good conduct. The services of Party No. 1 will be regularized w.e.f. the date of acquiring Ph.D. degree and his previous service will be counted for administrative and other service benefits. He will be required to execute agreement afresh after completion of each year of his service till his services are regularized. He will be required to appear before the committee constituted by the Director for regularization of his services.*

There was a condition contained in the appointment letter that the candidate will be appointed on the contract basis for a maximum period of five years, which will be renewable every years on the condition of good performance of teaching, good conduct and satisfactory progress in Ph.D. work. The appointment letter further provides that the contract position will be regularized w.e.f. the date of acquiring





Ph.D. degree at an appropriate AGP and increment as admissible. The condition further provided that this contractual service will be counted for administration and other service benefit. Almost the identical condition was also contained in the agreement as condition no. 2. I was fully aware of the fact that since at the time of the joining in the institute as an Assistant Professor, I had only M.Tech degree and my Ph.D. work was at advance stage, therefore, had accepted the said appointment letter.

In the meantime, the Ph.D. degree was awarded to me on 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 and, hence, the appropriate representation has been made to the Director, NIT UK, along with the copy of the Ph.D. degree (Provisional) on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2014, wherein a request has been made for regularization of service in accordance with the terms of letter of appointment and the contract for service. True copy of the representation dated 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2014 is attached herewith and marked as Annexure no. 5.

That since, no heed has been made, again a representation was made on 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 and in pursuance of the aforesaid representation so made, an office order was issued on 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2014, whereby I was directed to appear before the committee on 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 for considering the case for regularization. As per the order dated 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2014, I had appeared before the committee and made representation on 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2014. True copy of the communication dated 26-9-2014 and office order dated 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2014 are attached herewith and marked as Annexure no. 6 and 7.

As the committee has already considered the case for regularization in accordance with the letter of appointment and agreement so executed, no further steps have been taken for regularizing the service. Hence after waiting for the considerable period of time, I had again made a representation dated 25-2-2015 and 13-3-2015, but still no heed has been paid on the representations. True copy of the representations dated 25-2-2015 and 13-3-2015 are attached herewith and marked as Annexure no. 8 and 9.

In the similar set of circumstances, one of the faculty member, who was similarly placed like me at National Institute of Technology, Warangal, has been regularized way back on 9-7-2014 immediately after acquiring the Ph.D. degree. In the said case, the Ph.D. degree was awarded on 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2014. Copy of regularization order dated 9-7-2014 passed in favour of Dr. Arpan Mehar, is attached herewith and marked as Annexure no. 10.






Despite the fact that the repeated representations have been made and the hopes for vibrant academic and research atmosphere in the institute are getting bleak day by day and I am in dilemma, whether to continue in the institute or not.

Hence, I was not left with another equally efficacious remedy but to invoke extraordinary jurisdiction of the Hon'ble Court under section 226 of the constitution of India. Since applicant could not receive the certified copy of the order yet, therefore a copy obtained from official website of court is attached here as Annexure no. 11 and the certified copy of the order will be provided as soon as it is available to me.

The competent authority may be requested to consider it keeping in view my sustained professional growth with this newly born Institute of National Importance.

Respected Sir,

I joined this institution as Assistant Professor in Mechanical engineering department on 25/07/13 against office order no. NITUK/ESTT/2013/549 dated 07/06/13. I am performing my academic and administrative duties then onwards with self motivation and same can be accessed from the feedback of students and my Head of Department (reporting officer as per agreement dated 27/07/13).

Sir, I would like to bring in your kind consideration that the Director is intentionally harassing and creating administrative hassles to demoralize me to work in this Institution. As per Model recruitment rules of NIT and Agreement conditions dated 27/07/13, my service at this institute should be regularize from the date of acquiring of PhD degree i.e 20/08/14. Several correspondences with the Director were done vide letter ME/14/240 dated 01/09/14, vide letter ME/14/254 dated 26/09/14 and vide letter ME/15/121 dated 25/02/15 to regularize my services and to provide related benefits w.e.f acquiring of PhD degree. Even after my presentation in front of regularization committee constituted by the director on 09/10/14, the status of my service is not altered by the administration.

Apart from that it's highly unfortunate to write that the Director is creating unnecessary administrative hassles in my research activities at this institute. I had submitted a research proposal to Board of nuclear research (BRNS) for financial funding and after immense efforts, I got an opportunity to present my research proposal at BARC of 09/01/15. I discussed the matter with Director with expectation of a permission to present the proposal, but my expectation was come to ground when he used the words "You think that you are king. I am sitting over your research proposal". I requested the Director through several official correspondences (vide letter ME/15/007 dated 02/01/15 and vide letter ME/15/011 dated 05/01/15) and emails to grant permission for presenting my research proposal, but due to unnecessary administrative hassles created by the Director, I was not able to present it at BARC, Mumbai.

To avail research initiation grant (Basic fund provided by every NIT and IIT to start research activity), I had submitted a research proposal to administration on 14/12/13. Even after many

correspondences (vide letter ME/14/329 dated 01/12/14. vide letter ME/15/139 dated 09/03/15) with the Director in this matter till date no positive response has been received to me.

Still I am not loosing hopes and looking forward for a vibrant academic and research atmosphere at this Institute. Sir, you may kindly requested to look in this matter keeping in view my professional and personal growth with this Institution.


