A Committee of Subject Experts was constituted to review the progress and current status of their Ph.D. work. The report of the Committee of Subject Experts and the progress report received from respective Ph.D. supervisors of the above named Faculties will be tabled.

It is pertinent to mention the prevailing circumstances when the institute was established in a temporary campus in 2009 with three branches namely Electrical Engineering, Computer Science Engineering and Electronics Engineering, with yearly intake of 30 students per branch.

Mr. Kumar Gaurav, Mr. Vineet P. Chandran and Mr. Prakash Dwivedi have the distinction of being the first lot of regular Faculty members, appointed on contract through the first Faculty Recruitment Advertisement of NIT Uttarakhand dated 08/04/2012. Mr. Kumar Gaurav, Mr. Prakash Dwivedi and Mr. Vineet P. Chandran were first few and only regular Faculty in their respective departments during that time.

Since the Institute was struggling to establish & equip the Laboratories and built the necessary infrastructure in the temporary campus, the three above named Faculties had to shoulder additional responsibilities and were expected to devote day and night to design the labs, procurement process, supervision of infrastructure and many more such time consuming tasks. As a result, presumably, their research work for Ph.D. got neglected and this caused a delay in their acquiring the Ph.D. degree in time.

The Board is requested to deliberate upon the request placed at **Annexure BOG 16.02** for extension of Service Contract made by Mr. Kumar Gaurav, Mr. Vineet P. Chandran and Mr. Prakash Dwivedi.

Subject: Regarding request for extension of the contract period of appointment.

Respected Sir,

I, Mr. Kumar Gaurav, Assistant Professor (on contract) in Electronics Engineering Department had joined the Institute on 14th March 2013 under the tier-3 scheme. The appointment period was for five years with the condition that contract position will be regularized with effect from the date of acquiring the Ph.D. degree. I joined NIT Uttarakhand as a first faculty member in the department of Electronics Engineering. When I joined the institute, the entire institute was functioning from the Polytechnic campus, and the students of the department were studying in their second year. I was assigned with the responsibility to establish laboratory facility in the department along with teaching load. After few months of joining, construction of hostels and classroom at the polytechnic campus was started, and I had the responsibility to look after all audio-visual section and establish Internal Telephone Exchange for smooth conduction of the institutional work. At the same time, I was assigned with administrative responsibility of Associate Dean (Research and consultancy). I established integrated platform for computing and research work with the help of National Instruments that is useful for faculties as well as UG/PG students. As I didn't have much previous work experience related to this area. However, under the guidance of Hon'ble Director sir, I had completed all the work assigned to me. I was also a part of many committees during the initial phase of my service.

After the completion of approximately 10 months service, I took admission in Ph.D. (part time) in the CARE, IIT Delhi and relieved on dated 6th Jan, 2014 for the Ph.D. course work. But due to ill health I had to leave the PhD course work midway and returned to the Institute. My request for another opportunity to do the PhD has been approved in BOG 7th meeting dated 4th June, 2015. As per norms I returned the entire salary amount to the institute which I had withdrawn during deputation at IIT Delhi. After joining the institute, I was assigned recruitment duty and shifting of my department from Polytechnic campus to ITI campus.

Later, I got opportunity to be admitted in part time Ph.D. at NIT Kurukshetra on dated 11th Aug, 2014 and I was relieved for the course work on dated 16th Jan 2015 which was after five months from the date of admission. I had successfully completed course work (CGPA 8.00) and the comprehensive exam on June 2015 and Feb 2016 respectively. My research proposal was approved by DRC on 10th February 2016.

I have been teaching four (4) or five (5) courses in every semester as a coordinator or co-coordinator since my joining. I have also introduced new courses in the signal processing area for B.Tech and M.Tech program for Electronics department. Presently, I am teaching four courses (3 as coordinator and 1 as co-coordinator). I am also bearing an administrative


responsibility as an audio system in-charge of the institute. I have almost completed 4 year and 8 months of regular service in the institute.

Presently, the objectives of the research proposal have been almost completed. My research work is in advanced stage and two (02) research papers have been already accepted with following details (copy enclosed). I have been working hard to complete my Ph.D. within the stipulated time period. But there are various factors that may lead to delay in completion of Ph.D. within five years of my contact period.

Therefore, I humbly request you to provide me an extension of six months for the submission of my Ph.D. work, which would bring best of my teaching, research and administrative responsibilities bestowed upon me presently as well as in future. Losing the job may badly affect my career and aggravate the problem. I have also attached the minutes of meeting of other NITs where an extension has been provided to the faculty members for your kind reference. I shall be highly thankful to you.

Respected Sir,


I have joined the institute as Assistant Professor on contract on 18th April, 2013 under tier 3 scheme in the Department of Electrical Engineering. The contract period was for 5 years with the condition that the contract position will be terminated if PhD is not acquired in above said period.

After my joining on April 18th 2013, I had to wait till December 2013 (8 months) period to get my PHD admissions in IIT Delhi. I got my admission in Electrical Dept. of IIT Delhi under Prof. Bhim Singh as my supervisor. Initially when I joined there were only 4 faculty members (on contract) and institute was operating in Polytechnic campus. I had also got the opportunity to develop laboratories for UG and also have taken various responsibilities like Asso. Dean (FW), Electrical Maintenance I/c, C.V.O (Chief vigilance officer), and I/c Mountaineering club (currently) also have successfully completed these responsibilities. Since I am doing PHD in the area of Power Electronics I require a hardware setup to complete my PHD apart from multiple efforts I could not establish the required hardware setup in NIT Uttarakhand due to various constraints. In this semester I had to go through a surgery for infected Pinodial Sinus for which I was absent from duty from 7th sept, 2017 to 5th Dec, 2017 (90 days) and was under bed rest so I was not really able to work for my PHD. Due to above mentioned reasons I really require a time period of 2 more years from 19th April, 2018 to 18th April, 2020 to complete my PHD. Also I request you to grant me leave for 6 months in leave without pay scheme (EOL) so that I can work on my practical hardware available at IIT Delhi and get constant guidance for the same from my supervisor. I assure you that I will also try to setup the hardware what I have learned from IIT Delhi at NIT Uttarakhand during this period.



BoG 16.04 Regularization of Dr. Nitin Kumar, Assistant Professor (On Contract)

Dr. Nitin Kumar joined the Institute on 24.07.2013 as a Assistant Professor on contract with AGP ₹6000/-, in Three Tier Rigid Faculty Structure, on the basis of M.Tech qualification. He acquired Ph.D degree on 21.12.2015 and submitted the degree certificate to the Institute administration on 05.02.2016. As per the provision of Three Tier Rigid Faculty Structure, services of Dr. Nitin Kumar should have been regularized w.e.f 21.12.2015.

On 21.02.2016 institute advertised the vacancy for Assistant Professor under Four Tier Flexible Structure. In response to this Faculty Recruitment Advertisement, Dr. Nitin Kumar voluntarily applied for the post of Assistant Professor, on contract in AGP ₹6000/- with Ph.D increments, for which he obtained NOC from the Institute administration. He was selected by the Staff Selection Committee and was financially upgraded with suitable increments keeping in mind his Ph.D degree.

On 18.05.2016 he assumed the charge of Assistant Professor on contract in AGP ₹6000/- with five additional increments, in Four Tier Flexible Structure.
