The Senate approved the Ordinances, Rules and Regulations for Ph.D. Program in NIT, Uttarakhand with a change in minimum qualification for admission as a 1st class (C.P.I. or C.G.P.A. greater than 6.75 on a 10 pint scale) at Master's degree in the concerned or an allied subject or a minimum of 1st Class (C.P.I. or C.G.P.A. greater than 6.75 on a 10 pint scale) at Bachelors with at least 55% marks at Masters level shall be necessary. The Senate further resolved to delete the condition of 5 years experience in para 4.4.1 and also delete the condition regarding External Supervisorship for Ph.D program in para 4.4.4 (9).

01.05 To consider the faculty representation in the Board of Governors.
