As per approval of Senate 95 seats were approved for M.Tech Admission through CCMT and 25 seats under self-sponsored category Keeping in view the less number of admission in M.Tech Programme (54 admission in Year 2020, 22 admissions in Year 2021 and 17 admission in year 2022) data for three Academic Years (i.e. 2019-20; 2020-2021 and 2021-2022) was reviewed by HoDs and Deans and It was resolved that all Head of the Departments (Engineering) will make their best effort to fill at least 50% seats allocated in each specialization in the academic year 2022-2023. However, it was also proposed that to discontinue some of the specialization of the Departments in which admission are NIL or less. Accordingly, revised allocation prosed by HoDs and Deans is as under:

Agenda 34.14 (B): Approval regarding permission for Internship to the B.Tech students in Eighth semester.

As per resolution of Senate vide agenda No. S.31.06 (copy attached), B.Tech students can go for Internship in 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> Semester only. The Senate further resolved that the student may complete maximum of three courses from NPTEL during Internship and also removed the requirement of minimum CGPA to go for Internship. However the students are also getting the Internship opportunities in their Eighth semester through the Institute Career Counselling and Placement (C2P) section. In Even semesters 2023 there are ten students who are having the Internship offer till now (copy attached).

Senate is requested to deliberate upon the matter.

Resolution:

Since the students are getting the Internship opportunities in their 8<sup>th</sup> Semester also, Hence, keeping in view the students future, their placement opportunities and Industry Exposure through Internships, Senate approves that the students may be allowed to do Internship in the 8<sup>th</sup> Semester. Further the Senate also resolved that the student should

complete the following credits requirement for being eligible for Internship in 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> Semester of their B.Tech Programme.

- A Student who earns 104 credits at the end of 5th semester and is in a position to complete required BS/ES/HM/DC/DE/UN/OC courses in the remaining time is eligible for Internship in 6th semester.
- 2. A Student who earns 129 credits at the end of 6th semester and is in a position to complete required BS/ES/HM/DC/DE/UN/OC courses in the remaining time is eligible for Internship in 7th semester.
- 3. A Student who earns 154 credits at the end of 7th semester and has completed all the required BS/ES/HM/DC/DE/UN/OC courses is eligible for Internship in 8th semester.
- 4. In case credit requirement is not completed as per point 1.2 & 3, the student may be permitted to complete credit requirement by opting NPTEL/Swayam courses. Concerned Faculty advisor and HOD will ensure the credit requirement of the student alongwith equivalence of the course on the NPTEL/Swayam portal. Related registration/other fee will be borne by the students himself/herself, no financial implication will be on the part of Institute.

Senate further suggested that HODs alongwith Departmental Faculty Board will ensure that upto 20% courses of the programme in their Department should be equivalent to the courses available under NPTEL/Swayam portal, if not so, HODs alongwith their Departmental Faculty board may revise their curriculum with due approval.
