IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) The Institute has scrutinized the applications received for the post of Assistant Professor (Gr-II & Gr-I), Associate Professor and Professor against the advertisement Advt. No 10/2022 dated: 13/12/2022, Advt. No 13/2022 dated: 13/12/2022 and Advt. No 06/2022 dated: 18/08/2022, respectively.
- 2) The candidates found as Eligible and Provisional Eligible are subjected to verification of documents in original relating to their age, educational qualifications, credit points claimed, category certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PWD/EWS), experience, Pay level/Grade pay etc. at the time of written test and/or interview. During actual verification of original documents, if any discrepancy is noticed, candidate will not be allowed to appear for further selection process.
- 3) Candidates are requested to bring a 'No-Objection Certificate' from the present employer, in case he/she is employed in a Government, Semi Government, Autonomous organization including Public Sector undertaking etc. and whose application has not been forwarded through proper channel by the employer for this post. In the absence of 'No-Objection Certificate' the candidate will not be allowed to appear for the selection process.
- 4) The candidates who have not submitted their fee receipt are instructed to bring the original fee-receipt at the time of written test and interview. SC, ST, OBC(Non-Creamy Layer) and EWS candidates should bring a valid original community certificate as per the central list issued by the competent authority. OBC-NCL and EWS certificates should be obtained **on or after 01/04/2023**.
- 5) The exact venue and reporting time will be mentioned in the call letter for different positions and call letters will be sent through email. Candidates are advised to reach the venue at least one hour prior to schedule reporting time, so that they do not face any difficulty in locating the venue.
- 6) All shortlisted candidates for Assistant Professor Grade- II will have to appear for the Written Test & Interview on the scheduled date(s) and time and they are not allowed to carry any personal belongings including electronic devices, mobile phones, smart watch etc. at the Examination Centre. Institute will not be responsible for safety of personal belongings of the candidates. Document verification will be conducted for the candidates qualified in the written test.
- 7) All shortlisted candidates for Assistant Professor Gr-I, Associate Professor and Professor will have to appear for the documentation verification and Interview on the scheduled date(s) and time.
- 8) No TA/DA will be provided for appearing in the Written Test and/or Interview.
- 9) Candidates should make their own arrangements for stay and other logistics.
- 10) No correspondence will be entertained from candidates not considered for Written Test/Interview/Appointment.
- 11) Candidates are advised to check updates on NIT, Uttarakhand website regularly.

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IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES REGARDING THE WRITTEN TEST

1. Each candidate must enter the examination venue minimum 30 minutes before the commencement of the examination.
2. Any candidate reporting after the scheduled time of starting the examination will not be allowed strictly in the examination hall.
3. **Candidates are not allowed to appear in the examination hall with mobile phone or any electronics device(Bluetooth devices, earphones, earbuds etc.) . If anybody is caught with mobile or any electronics device during the examination, he/she will be debarred immediately from the examination and no request will be entertained. Also, such candidate will not be considered for any recruitment of NIT Uttarakhand in future.**
4. The use of the programmable calculator in the examination is strictly prohibited.
5. Each candidate must keep his/her valid Identity card (Aadhaar, Driving License, etc.,) while entering the examination hall.
6. The candidate has to sit according to their seating arrangement in the examination hall.
7. The candidate should not keep any papers, notes or other things with them. In case of doubt, invigilator can do physical frisking of the candidate.
8. The candidate should write down his/her application number, category and put signature with date on the question paper. Writing about anything except these on the question paper is strictly prohibited.
9. Each candidate should carry required items for examination. Nobody is allowed to exchange anything (e.g. Pen, pencil, calculator, eraser, scale, etc.) in the examination hall.
10. Candidate should not talk to each other and must not create any disturbance in the examination hall.
11. Candidate should write their answers/options in the specified space only and no over-writing is permitted. Rough work should be done only in the specified space given at the end of the question paper. Tick mark or encircling the options on the question papers will not be treated as "Correct" answer.
12. Red ink is not allowed to write the answers. Use blue or black ball-point pen only.
13. Candidates appearing for written test are not allowed to go out of the examination hall during the examination.
14. The candidate should hand over their question paper sheet to the invigilator before leaving the examination hall. The candidate has to ensure that the attendance sheet is signed before leaving the examination hall.
