

Instructions to 1st Year B. Tech. Candidates (For all candidates allotted seats in normal and Special rounds) regarding Institute Reporting/Admission for the Academic Year 2023-2024

1. Physical Reporting details:

Reporting Dates for Institute admission	14 Aug 2023 (Monday) to 21 Aug 2023 (Monday)
Reporting Time	10:30 AM to 5:00 PM.
Reporting Venue	Academic Section, ITI Campus NIT Uttarakhand, Srinagar (Garhwal), Uttarakhand.

2. Documents required at the time of Admission:

A. Following documents in original are required for Institute admission:

1. Admit Card of JEE (Main)-2023.
2. Score Card of JEE (Main)-2023
3. Class X Mark Sheet and Certificate
4. Class XII Mark Sheet and Certificate (Qualifying Examination)
5. Photo ID proof as per Govt. of India norms.
6. Original Aadhar Card
7. Proof of payment of Seat Acceptance Fee (SAF)/Partial Admission Fee (PAF) (for candidates allotted seat in 1st to 6th rounds of JoSAA).
8. Proof of Payment of Special Round Fee (i.e., Special Round Processing Fee (SRPF)+Institute Admission Fee-I (IAF-I) + Institute Admission Fee-II (IAF-II)) (for candidates allotted seat in CSAB Special rounds 1st and 2nd).
9. Proof of payment of balance Institute & Hostel fees or Institutes fees.
10. Transfer Certificate (Original to be submitted at the time of admission).
11. Migration Certificate (Original to be submitted at the time of admission).
12. Latest Character Certificate. (Original to be submitted at the time of admission).
13. Certificate of category (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/GEN-EWS/PWD), if applicable, as per Government of India format, available on the JoSAA 2023 website, issued by the competent authority. Persons with Disabilities (PWD) must bring UDID certificate/ card or certificate issued from a duly constituted Medical Board. **In case of OBC-NCL/GEN-EWS category, the certificate must be issued on or after April 01, 2023.**
14. Passport, if the candidate has passed the qualifying examination from outside India. This is required for determining the 'Country from which eligible'.
15. Proof of place of examination centre of the final examination for the candidates having senior Secondary certificate from the National Open School. This is required for determining the 'State of eligibility'.

Please note that

- i) *Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra State must be validated by Social Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL category) and Tribal Welfare department (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government. The SC/ST/OBCNCL candidates of Maharashtra State have to produce their caste validity certificate in the format available on JoSAA 2023 website.*
- ii) *ST certificates from Tamil Nadu state must be issued by the concerned Revenue Divisional Officer.*

16. Print copy of the Registration form and the locked choices downloaded from the JoSAA/CSAB-2023 portal through candidate's login, duly signed by the candidate.
17. Provisional Seat Allotment Letter (PSAL) of the finally allotted seat in JoSAA Round-6/CSAB Special Round-2 downloaded from the JoSAA/CSAB-2023 portal through candidate's login, duly signed by the candidate.
18. Document Verification cum seat Acceptance letter.
19. Medical Certificate (in specified Format available on JoSAA 2023 format).
20. One set of self-attested photocopies of all the original documents mentioned above.
21. 10 Passport size color photographs.

Note:

If the original certificates are not in English/Hindi, English/Hindi version/translation of such certificates, duly certified by the Principal/Director or other competent authority of the graduating Institute, will be required during the verification of documents.

3. Candidate is required to submit anti-ragging undertakings online through www.antiragging.in.

Step 1: Log on to www.antiragging.in or www.AMANMOVEMENT.org. Click on the button called – Register for Undertaking.

Step 2: Select your university as 'NIT Uttarakhand' and fill all the information by providing college number '9557750897' as required and submit the form. Step 3: On successful submission, you will receive an e-mail with your registration number and a web link. You are required to forward the same link to ar.sw@nituk.ac.in with a copy to academics@nituk.ac.in.

4. How to reach NIT Uttarakhand Campus

Temporary Campus is located in Govt. Polytechnic College, Srinagar Garhwal (Distt. Pauri Garhwal, Uttarakhand) at Srinagar. Srinagar is about 105 KM from Rishikesh on National Highway No. 58 leading to Badrinath (about 193 KM from Srinagar). Rishikesh is the nearest Railway Station. Haridwar, a major Railway station in Uttarakhand is about 140 KM from

Srinagar Garhwal. Nearest Airport at Jolly Grant, Dehradun is about 125 KM away from Srinagar Garhwal. Taxis are available for Srinagar Garhwal from Airport. Buses and Taxis are available for Srinagar from Dehradun/Rishikesh/Haridwar. It takes around 3 hours to reach Srinagar from Rishikesh. In rainy season, road may be blocked due to land sliding. Candidates are requested to keep a spare day while planning for reporting. Alternate way to reach Srinagar is from Kotdwara (via Pauri), which is about 140 KM and takes around 5 to 6 hours.
