

Instructions to 1st Year M. Tech. Candidates (For all candidates allotted seats in normal and Spot rounds) regarding Institute Reporting/Admission for the Academic Year 2023-2024.

Physical Reporting details:

Reporting Dates for Institute admission: 17th to 21st August, 2023.

Reporting Time: 09.30 AM to 4.00 PM.

Reporting Venue: Academic Section, ITI Campus,

NIT Uttarakhand, Srinagar (Garhwal), Uttarakhand.

1. Documents required at the time of Admission:

A. Following documents in original are required for Institute admission:

- (a) **Document for Proof of date of birth:** Class X marksheet/ certificate issued by the school last attended/ Recognized educational board containing the date of birth of the applicant. In case, class X marksheet/certificate does not contain date of birth, the candidate is required to upload class X marksheet/ certificate and any other Government issued document containing date of birth of the applicant, name and Parent's name such as Passport/ Aadhar Card/ Driving License/Voter ID Card/ PAN Card/ Birth Certificate issued by Municipal Corporation/authority empowered to register the birth.
 - (b) Photo ID proof as per Govt. of India norms.
 - (c) Mark Sheet of Class XII.
 - (d) Grade/Mark sheets of qualifying examination for all semesters.
 - (e) Degree/ Provisional certificate. If the result of qualifying degree is awaited, certificate of course completion from the institute/university last studied must be provided in the prescribed format available on the CCMT website.
 - (f) GATE Score Card (2021/2022/2023).
 - (g) Certificate of category (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS), if applicable, as per Government of India format, available on the CCMT website, issued by the competent authority. **In case of OBC-NCL/ EWS category, the certificate must be issued on or after April 01, 2023.**
 - (h) Undertaking by the candidate on OBC-NCL status in the prescribed format available on CCMT website.
 - (i) Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PwD), if applicable, issued by the Competent authority. Refer CCMT website for format.
 - (j) Proof of payment of Seat Acceptance Fee (SAF).
- B. Original Migration certificate of Institute/University last attended.**
- C. Original Conduct certificate of Institute/University last attended.**
- D. Original Transfer certificate of Institute/University last attended.**
- E. Print copy of the Registration form and the locked choices downloaded from the CCMT portal through candidate's login, duly signed by the candidate.
- F. Provisional Seat Allotment Letter (PSAL) of the finally allotted seat in Round-3/Special Round 2/ National Spot Round downloaded from the CCMT portal through candidate's login, duly signed by the candidate.
- G. Online Document Verification Certificate (ODVC) downloaded from the CCMT portal through candidate's login after successful Online Document Verification, duly signed by the candidate.

- H. Photocopy of Aadhar Card.
- I. One set of self-attested photocopies of all the original documents mentioned in points from 'a' to 'g'. The original documents mentioned in these points will be returned to the candidate after verification.
- J. 10 Passport size color photographs.
- K. Proof of payment of partial admission fees on CCMT portal (for candidates allotted seat in 1st to 3rd round).
- L. Proof of payment of balance Institute & Hostel fees or Institutes fees.

(B) Candidate is required to submit anti-ragging undertakings online through www.antiragging.in.
Step 1: Log on to www.antiragging.in or www.AMANMOVEMENT.org. Click on the button called – Register for Undertaking. **Step 2:** Select your University as 'NIT Uttarakhand' and fill all the information by providing college number '9557750897' as required and submit the form. **Step 3:** On successful submission, you will receive an e-mail with your registration number and a web link. You are required to forward the same link to ar.sw@nituk.ac.in with a copy to academics@nituk.ac.in.

Note: If the original certificates are not in English/Hindi, English/Hindi version/translation of such certificates, duly certified by the Principal/Director or other competent authority of the graduating institute, will be required during the document verification.

2. How to reach NIT Uttarakhand Campus:

Temporary Campus is located in Govt. Polytechnic College, Srinagar Garhwal (Distt. Pauri Garhwal, Uttarakhand) at Srinagar. Srinagar is about 105 KM from Rishikesh on National Highway No. 58 leading to Badrinath (about 193 KM from Srinagar). Rishikesh is the nearest Railway Station. Haridwar, a major Railway station in Uttarakhand is about 140 KM from Srinagar Garhwal. Nearest Airport at Jolly Grant, Dehradun is about 125 KM away from Srinagar Garhwal. Taxis are available for Srinagar Garhwal from Airport. Buses and Taxis are available for Srinagar from Dehradun/Rishikesh/Haridwar. It takes around 3 hours to reach Srinagar from Rishikesh. In rainy season, road may be blocked due to land sliding. Candidates are requested to keep a spare day while planning for reporting. Alternate way to reach Srinagar is from Kotdwara (via Pauri), which is about 140 KM and takes around 5 to 6 hours.

3. Important Instructions to the students:

- (i) Candidates are instructed to come with all essential items with them as the physical classes will be started from **22nd August, 2023** at the Institute
- (ii) The orientation program will be conducted on **21st August, 2023**. All students are required to attend the orientation program.
- (iii) Institute Hostel Facility is available for all the M.Tech. Students.
- (iv) Each First Year M. Tech. candidate and his/her parent/ guardian has to submit affidavits regarding anti-ragging at the time of reporting to this Institute for admission. It is compulsory for each student and his/her parent/guardian to submit the affidavits at the time of reporting for admission.

- (v) Students are required to appear in a screening test in English and Mathematics. The schedule of examinations will be intimated during admission. The students who are below satisfactory level in these tests are required to register for additional Preparatory English and Mathematics courses. Each student is required to get a valid pass grade in these courses in order to be eligible for graduation. The students who will not appear in the examination shall be treated as failed and they have to register for preparatory English and Mathematics courses.
- (vi) Institute is very strict about attendance in the class and does not accept any excuse for absenteeism. Students are advised to read the Ordinances available on Institute website and read carefully the rules regarding absenteeism in the class and Examination. Institute does not use any discretion for any reason to relax any of these stipulated conditions.
- (vii) Candidates are advised to visit the Institute website (www.nituk.ac.in) frequently to get more updates/any change in schedule of Institute admission/other information.
