BoG 46.05: To apprise the Board about construction activities, status of procurement of Financial Year 2022-23 and note the Audit Inspection Report for the financial year 2020-21 and 2021-22.

(A) To apprise the Board about the disbursement of first installment amounting to Rs.10,98,000,00/- from HEFA Loan.

Subsequent to the completion of tendering for work construction phase-II by CPWD, communication was made with HEFA for disbursement of the first installment amounting Rs.10,98,00,000/- i.e. 33-1/3% of Rs.32,94,29,959/- (quoted by L1 vendor) against the construction of work phase-II of NIT Uttarakhand – Srinagar campus.

For availing this disbursement, Institute transferred an amount of Rs.3,29,68,500/- (10% of the half yearly installment amount) and an amount of Rs.29,67,16,500/- (90% of the half yearly installment), accumulating to Rs.32,96,85,000/- to Escrow 3 Account (Principal Repayment Account; A/c No.: 120000588506, Branch: Canara Bank, Srinagar Garhwal Branch, Uttarakhand).

An amount of Rs.10,98,000,00/- has been transferred to CPWD by HEFA on 29.03.2023.

The Board is requested to note the same.

Resolution: Noted.

(B) To apprise the Board about the activities related to construction work phase-II at NIT Uttarakhand, Srinagar Campus.

The statutory bodies of the Institute i.e. the Building and Works Committee (vide resolve BWC 08.08, the Finance Committee (vide resolve FC 22.06), and the Board of Governors (vide resolve BoG 27.06) has approved the project for "Site

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Development and the Construction of Non-Residential & Residential Buildings at Extension Campus of NIT Uttarakhand at Srinagar (Garhwal)" for a total cost of Rs.78,44,94,733/- (Rupees Seventy-eight crores forty-four lakhs ninety-four thousand seven hundred and thirty-three rupee only). The project was split in two phases. For Phase – I, the Administrative Approval & Expenditure Sanction amounting to Rs.37.73 crores was issued to CPWD for work construction and the work is under progress by CPWD.

The Building & Works Committee in its 16th meeting resolved that Administrative Approval & Expenditure Sanction (AA&ES) for phase-II may be released after the tendering process and disbursement of HEFA loan.

Subsequent to above, Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction (A/A & E/S) amounting to Rs.32,94,29,959/- for the work of the Construction of Phase-II has been granted to Central Public Works Department (CPWD) vide letter no. NITUK/P&D/2023/2466, dated 30-03-2023. Along with AA & E/S an advance of Rs.10,98,000,00/- has been transferred to CPWD by HEFA. The project will be completed by 31st July, 2024.

The Board is requested to note the same.

Resolution: **Noted.**

(C) To apprise the Board about status of work construction phase-I at NIT Uttarakhand- Srinagar Campus.

As per the mutually agreed time schedule, the construction work was to be completed by 31.07.2021. A revised programme chart was submitted by CPWD mentioning that work shall be completed by 31.12.2021, but till February, 2023 only 75% physical progress was achieved by the agency.

The present status of construction work is summarized as under:

1. Hostel Block A – Handed-over for occupancy on 04.11.2022.
2. Hostel Block B – Handed-over for occupancy on 06.12.2022.
3. Hostel Block C – Structural work completed. Brick work going-on.
4. Hostel Block D – Structural work completed. Finishing work going-on.
5. Hostel Block E – Finishing work going-on. Likely to be Handed-over in April, 2023.
6. Dinning Block – Handed-over for occupancy on 28.02.2023.
7. Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) – Operational.
8. Under Ground Water Tank (UGT) – Operational.
9. Electric Sub-Station (ESS) – Partially operational.
10. Boundary Wall and Gate – Incomplete.
11. Site Development – Incomplete.

(D) To apprise the Board about status of construction and development of infrastructural facilities at NIT Uttarakhand- Sumari Campus.

The tender for construction and development of infrastructural facilities at NIT Uttarakhand-Sumari Campus was floated by NBCC (India) Ltd. Subsequently technical and financial bid were opened. However, one of the bidders filed writ petition at Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. The matter was presented to the BoG of the Institute (BoG 45.01). The BoG in its 45th meeting resolved that the matter regarding qualified bidders is subjudice in the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi, therefore, as recommended by the Finance Committee any course of action on this tender shall be taken after decision of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi at New Delhi. The committee deliberated on the matter in its meeting held on 29.03.2023, 31.03.2023, 03.04.2023 and 11.04.2023. Members have been discussed the following issue with representative of NBCC, Sh. Yogesh Sharma, Executive Director:

- Higher cost of the project, as projected by the NBCC, including the justification of L1
- Implications of the current Writ Petition on time and cost of the project
- Possibility of re-tendering and the expedited time lines for award of work, including legal safeguards
- Concerns related to some of the tender conditions which were found by the Committee to be unreasonable and restrictive for participation of more bidders
- Possible scope for cost reduction, especially in respect of excavation, retaining walls, reducing foot print and any other options, CCTV, A/V systems, G+3 instead of G+2 etc.

Representative of NBCC agreed to present most suitable alternative way forward for consideration in the next meeting which is schedule on 11th April, 2023.

The committee report will be presented in the Board meeting.

It is also to apprise to the Finance Committee that NBCC (India) Ltd. has requested NIT Uttarakhand vide letter (Ref. No.: NBCC/SBG/N&U/GM/2023/103 dated 25/03/2023) to provide the Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction (A/A&E/S) citing the reason that during the hearing, Hon'ble Judge, High Court of Delhi has clarified that "As no Stay Order has been passed against NBCC in awarding the Contract, NBCC is free to act in furtherance to the tendering procedure".

However, no such proof of court order regarding tendering procedure has been attached. In this regard a communication has been made with NBCC (India) Ltd. to provide the justification for release of the Administrative Approval and Expenditure Sanction (A/A&E/S). The court orders of 30.01.2023 and 23.03.2023 are attached in **(Annexure BoG 46.03-A)**. The next date of hearing

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is 09.05.2023.

The Board is requested to deliberate the same.

Resolution: As recommended by the Finance Committee, the committee report is accepted by the Board. Institute need to expedite the further process with NBCC.

(E) Status of procurement against Revised Annual Procurement Plan (APP) for the Financial Year 2022-23.

The revised Annual Procurement Plan for Financial Year 2022-23 was approved by the Board in its 44th meeting vide agenda item BoG 44.19. As per the revised Annual Procurement Plan (APP) for the Financial Year 2022-23 the total amount of Rs.4,00,05,482.00 has been spent for procurement under the Head-35 (Annexure BoG 46.03-B).

The Board is requested to note the same.

Resolution: Noted.

(F) To note the Audit Inspection Report for the financial year 2020-21 and 2021-22.

The office of the C&AG has conducted audit of the Institute for the period from April 2020 to March 2022 during 10.10.2022 to 09.11.2022. Copy of final Audit Inspection Report (AIR) received from Audit office is enclosed as (Annexure BoG 46.03-C). Details are as under:

BoG 46.08: Conversion of 07 posts of Technician (Selection Grade-II) in to Senior Technician.

Presently total sanctioned non-teaching posts of the Institute are 95. Out of the 95 sanctioned posts, 07 posts are sanctioned as Technician (Selection Grade-II) (Group C, Grade Pay 2800). The method of recruitment for Technician (Selection Grade-II), as per recruitment rules, is 100% by promotion.

The eligibility criterion for promotion to Technician (Selection Grade-II) as per recruitment rules is as under:

“At least 5 years regular service with Grade Pay of Rs.2400/- as Senior Technician through DPC and working performance record (APAR), through prescribed test and interview.”

Presently no post of Senior Technician is sanctioned to the Institute. Thus due to non-sanctioning of Senior Technician, the 07 posts of the Technician (Selection Grade-II) are vacant since 2015.

Presently Institute is having 18 filled positions of Technician (Grade Pay 2000) and the next higher post of Technician is Senior Technician (Grade Pay 2400). As per recruitment rules of the NITs, the method of recruitment of Senior Technician (Grade Pay 2400) is 50% by direct recruitment and 50% by promotion. The eligibility criterion for promotion to Senior Technician is as under:

“At least 5 years regular service as Technician in PB-1, GP 2000/- or at least 5 years combined service of Lab. Attendant (SG-II) and Technician in PB-1, Grade Pay of Rs.2000/- through DPC and working performance record (APAR), through prescribed test and interview.”

All the 18 Technicians of the Institute have completed 5 years of service for promotion as Senior Technician. But due to non-availability of sanctioned post of Senior Technician, the promotions are pending since long.

As per Section 5, Sub Section (i) of the NIT Statutes, the Board is empowered to abolish, re-designate or change the nomenclature of any post in the Institute.

Keeping in view the promotional aspects of the Technicians of the Institute, It is proposed that the 07 posts of Technician (Selection Grade-II) (Group C, Grade Pay 2800) may be converted in to 07 posts of Senior Technician (Group C, Grade Pay 2400). Such conversion will not exceed the total number of sanctioned non-teaching posts and will have no additional financial implications.

The Board is requested to approve the proposal and further requested to allow to fill all 07 posts of senior technician through promotion only.

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Resolution: Matter be referred to the NIT Bureau in MoE for clarification as per RRs of the Non-Teaching.

BoG 46.09: Conversion of 05 posts of Higher Technical Staff to Higher Ministerial Staff.

The sanctioning scale of the Higher Technical Staff (Grade Pay 4200) is 30% of the total sanctioned faculty strength whereas the sanctioning scale of the Higher Ministerial Staff (Grade Pay 4200) is 8% of the total sanctioned faculty strength. Presently total sanctioned faculty strength of NIT Uttarakhand is 86. Therefore, 27 posts of Higher Technical Staff (Grade Pay 4200) and 07 posts of Higher Ministerial Staff are sanctioned to the Institute.

Institute administration has many full flagged sections namely Establishment, Account, Stores and Purchase, Academic, Hostels, Training and Placement, RTI, Legal, Office of the Director, Office of the Registrar and office of the Deans”.

It is to submit that Office of the Director, Office of the Registrar, office of the Deans, Legal Section, Hostel Section, Academic Section and RTI Section are functioning without regular Superintendent (Higher Ministerial Staff, Grade Pay 4200).

As per Section 5, Sub Section (i) of the NIT Statutes, the Board is empowered to abolish, re-designate or change the nomenclature of any post in the Institute.

Hence for the smooth functioning of the all the administrative sections of the Institute, It is proposed to convert 05 posts out of 27 posts of Higher Technical Staff in to Higher Ministerial Staff (Superintendent post, Grade Pay 4200). Such conversion will not exceed the total number of sanctioned non-teaching posts with in the same Grade Pay and will have no additional financial implications.

The Board is requested to approve the above proposal. Vacancies shall be advertised accordingly in upcoming non-teaching recruitment drive.

Resolution: Withdrawn.

BoG 46.10: Conversion of 04 posts of Technician to Bus/Car Driver.

Institute is having 04 vehicles. Out of 04 vehicles, 01 is staff car under LMV category and 03 vehicles (one ambulance and two buses) are under HMV category. Presently all 04 vehicles are being operated by the drivers hired through outsource agency.

As services of the ambulance and buses are used by the students hence role of driver become very important. Generally the outsourced employees do not take the ownership towards institute and its properties.

Presently total sanctioned post for Technician (Grade Pay 2000) is 15. Hence for the smooth functioning of all the vehicles of the Institute, It is proposed to convert 04 posts out of 15 posts of Technician (Grade Pay 2000) in to Bus/Car Driver (Grade Pay 2000). Such conversion will not exceed the total number of sanctioned non-teaching posts and will have no additional financial implications. As there are no Recruitment Rules for the Bus/Car Driver therefore, following Recruitment Rules are also proposed for the recruitment of Bus/Car Driver:

Mr. Nitesh Kumar has joined the Institute 02.07.2015 (AN) and he has executed a contract agreement with the Institute on 11.07.2015 **(Annexure BoG 46.15-B)**.

As per Trainee Teacher scheme the appointment of Trainee Teacher was on contractual basis at National Institute of Technologies (NIT's) subject to enrolment of the candidates in Indian Institute of Technologies (IIT's) for M.Tech and Ph.D.

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Programme. Accordingly, he was deputed for M.Tech and Ph.D. course work at IIT, Roorkee w.e.f. 23.07.2015 (AN).

As per point no.2 of salient features of the scheme, the duration for completing M.Tech. and Ph.D. Programme as maximum eight (08) years and as per point no.8 if a Trainee Teacher fails to acquire Ph.D. in the maximum stipulated time, he/she will be discontinued from this scheme.

As per point no.2 of the agreement mentioned above, "The Party No.1 shall be on service under the agreement for a maximum period of eight years. The contract shall be renewed after one year on satisfactory, performance in teaching, good conduct and progress in M.Tech. and Ph.D. work to be obtained annually. If the progress in M.Tech. and Ph.D. work is not found satisfactory at any point of time during the contract period, the services of Party no.1 can be terminated without giving any notice.


Mr. Nitesh Kumar is going to complete his eight years of service on 02.07.2023 and he has still not submitted his Ph.D. degree to the Institute. A request has been received from Mr. Nitesh Kumar for extension of service contract period for six months (Annexure BoG 46.15-C).

The Board is requested to deliberate upon and issue the necessary directions.

Resolution: The extension of 06 months is granted subject to the condition that Trainee Teacher has to submit the Ph.D. Thesis latest by 20.06.2023.


It was also decided that the next Board meeting will be held on **14.08.2023** (Monday).
